

# Loan of Shropshire Astronomical Society equipment

## Equipment:

- EXT125 with set of 8 Meade eyepieces, Tripod and Powerpack
- 6" Dobsonian and mount with 10mm and 25mm eyepieces and 2x Barlow
- 6" f8 Fullerscopes telescope
- 80mm short box reflector telescope
- MX716 camera
- Minitron video camera

## Small print(!)

1. The equipment is loaned free of charge for a period of at least one month.
2. You must ensure that you are adequately trained to use the equipment by an experienced member of the society.
3. You undertake to bring the equipment to the next Rodington observing meeting to renew the loan or to contact the curator before the meeting to renew by phone (01939 291352) if no-one else has asked to borrow the equipment.
4. If another member has asked to borrow the equipment you must return it at the next Rodington observing meeting or return it to the curator before the meeting.
5. The equipment must be returned in the same condition as it was received.
6. Any equipment damaged whilst loaned to you must be repaired to the same condition or **replaced with new** by you – be aware that some of this equipment is expensive.
7. You **must not** ‘sub-let’ the equipment to anyone else – if you wish to pass it to another member they will need to sign for it with the curator. It must not be lent to non-members.

8. You must use it to observe the heavens (in so far as the Shropshire climate allows), and I hope you will tell us about how you got on with it at one of the Rodington meetings whilst we wait for the clouds to part
